

PUBLISH AN ANCIENT NEWSPAPER

Put together a newspaper that tells about important people, places, and events of ancient Rome. Decide on a clever name for your paper. Then, choose people, places, and events that you will include in the paper, and decide how you will show them. You could show them in a weather report, an obituary, a biography, and in stories. Illustrate your newspaper with drawings and advertisements that relate to that time.

Your newspaper must have the following:

- A title banner with the name of your paper and the date.
- A main article that's at least 150 words long with 3 or more paragraphs.
- One small article that is 1 to 2 paragraphs
- An advertisement
- A picture with a caption. (can be hand-drawn or from the internet)
- Choose one: weather report, obituary, or biography

Your newspaper will need to include 3 people, 2 places, and 2 events

Extra Credit: 2nd small article

Hints:

- Newspapers are written in 3rd person (Don't use "I")
- Newspapers answer the questions – who, what, where, when, and why
- Remember to include the minimum six elements above. You may include more.
- Be creative.
- Must be written in your own words.
- This assignment will be marked using the rubric on the back. This is a major grade.
